Subject: Transit Pilot Program Updates

Meeting Date: June 19, 2024

Recommendation:

THAT Report CAO2024-05 be received for information.

AND THAT Staff are authorized to amend the transit program schedule to reflect the Tuesday to Friday routes provided in said report.

AND FURTHER THAT staff adopt a user fee rate of \$5.00 per entry onto the bus for users 13 years of age and older.

Report:

We are approaching the end of the Township's inaugural six months of the pilot EZTransit program. Ridership numbers have been consistently averaging 3-5 users per day with in-week ridership being significantly more popular than weekend use. Trips to Stratford and Woodstock through the week are equally well attended while the weekend routes alternating between the two cities have seen significantly less ridership. Staff are recommending routes be adjusted to run from Tuesday to Friday with two routes (Tuesday, Thursday) to Stratford and two routes (Wednesday, Friday) to Woodstock. Currently the bus runs Wednesday to Saturday, with Wednesday and Friday plus alternating Saturdays to Woodstock and Thursdays plus alternating Saturdays to Stratford.

Survey data and a comparison schedule regarding fare rates and payment types have been included in the Attachments section for Council's consideration. Staff are recommending a fee of \$5.00 per person per entry onto the bus would be reasonable with no fare to be charged for children under the age of thirteen (13). This is in

recognition of the fact that no person under thirteen (13) may ride the bus without adult supervision. This is slightly below the average survey-recommended rate of \$8.00 but is consistent with other transit service provider fees.

Staff are currently investigating a mobile debit card solution for use on the bus itself. While bus "tickets" and 20-ride passes will be sold at locations in Tavistock, Hickson and possibly Innerkip for \$5.00 per ticket or \$100.00 per 20-ride pass payable by cash or debit. 20-ride passes would be "punched" for each chargeable entry and if the holder of the pass has leftover "punches" at the end of the pilot transit program, they could receive a refund of \$5.00 per residual punch providing the card is returned as proof of refund request. Both passes and tickets will be numbered for audit and financial tracking purposes.

Staff will be bringing back another report, in October, providing further feedback and data to allow Council to consider any changes, updates or additions to the transit program for the fall/winter of 2024.

Financial Implications:

 The estimates for revenue based on average ridership of 3-5 riders per day while generate modest revenue of approximately \$25.00/day or \$100/week. The intent of the user fee is simply to offset some of the operating costs of this pilot program and limit the impact on the operating budget in 2024.




