The Skating Club consists of 3 programs:

- 1. CanSkate our learn to skate program
- 2. StarSkate our star levels skaters, more advanced skaters testing at different levels and some skaters compete individually
- 3. Synchro 9 teams in total, 4 youth and 5 adult

In total we have roughly 180 synchro skaters and 146 CanSkate/StarSkate skaters for the 2024-2025 season. Roughly 50 of those youth synchro skaters are also our club skaters. Pretty amazing to have that many skaters in one small town club!

The synchro teams starts practicing the Tuesday after civic holiday weekend. Our August schedule is:

- Tuesdays and Thursdays 4-10pm, weeks 1,2,4
- Synchro Camp is the 3rd week. We have ice Monday to Thursday starting each day at 9am, 2 nights we are done at 4pm, the other 2 days done at 8pm
- 6 synchro teams skate out of Tavistock starting in August, the other 3 are out of Burlington simply because Tavistock does not have the ice availability and our synchro coach lives in Burlington. All synchro skaters represent the Tavistock club under our Team Unity name.

Our Tavistock based synchro teams go to other centres to practice while the fair is on and then they are back to normal practices as soon as we are able to get back on the ice. As well our regular club skating starts as soon as we can get on the ice after the fair. We skate all the way through until May long weekend.

Throughout the season, 2 of our competitive synchro teams practice 1-2x/week in other centres - primarily Stratford, but when Stratford ice is not available, they go to KW region, Woodstock. There simply not enough ice availability for the skating club. Every

year we ask for more ice in Tavistock, and we seem to gain half an hour to an hour some years.
